Tripod vessel

In this case are shown plates, bowls, cups and vases. The material and characteristics are examples of local tradition and trade evidences with central Veracruz and other peoples of Mesoamerica, especially the Central Highlands, from which came ceramic type "orange thin " with its rich forms, ranging from small plates with annular support, to richly decorated tripod vases placed by applications. We suggest looking at the local pottery, from La Mixtequilla, decorated with rich geometric and zoomorphic fitomorfos, made by painting and sgraffito.
